Vikram Bhatt's 'Creature 3D' Is A Brahmarakshas!

Vikram Bhatt is gearing up for the release of his upcoming film **Creature 3D**, which will be India's first 3D creature film. While everyone must have thought that Vikram would take inspiration from Hollywood creatures like **Godzilla** and **Anaconda**, it has now been revealed that the filmmaker's **Creature** is a Brahmarakshas.

When asked why he chose a Brahmarakshas for his film, Bhatt said that he didn't want to borrow from American culture and therefore, chose a mutant from the Indian mythology. He has revealed that the monster in his film is 10-feet tall, has a swishing tail and is in the same league as the Yeti.

Vikram has stated that he first went to a couple of foreign studios to create the creature however, when they quoted a very high price for it, he approached Chennai-based Prasad EFX, where finally his creature was made.
